

The ICSA 1995 Applied Statistics Symposium on April 15, 1995 has successfully finished at the Janice H. Levin Hall of the Rutgers University in New Jersey. About 100 people attended the conference. Thanks to the hard work of the symposium committee, everything went smoothly.

The symposium started with the keynote speaker session of 'Two-stage design of dose-response study' presented by Professor Jeff Wu (organized by Professor George Tiao). This session was followed by four concurrent sessions which discussed the financial ecometrics, statistical applications on AIDS research, non-clinical statistical issues in the drug discovery development processes, and a dialogue between biostatisticians and pharmaceutical scientists to discuss the efficiency of conducting pharmacokinetics and statistical analysis.

We had another 4 concurrent sessions in the first half of the afternoon. The topics presented were statistical applications in the industrial experiments, new statistical methodologies, population pharmaco-statistic modeling, and the continue dialogue between biostatisticians and pharmaceutical scientists.

The second half of the afternoon was for the panel discussion to enhance the ICSA membership services. With ten distinguished panelists from academic, governmental, and industrial institutions, this session was organized and chaired by Dr. Irving Hwang. The discussion covered a wide range of topics which will be summarized by Dr. Hwang and forwarded to the President and the Board of Directors of ICSA for possible resolutions and actions.

On the behalf of the symposium committee, I would like to express my most sincere appreciation for the participation of the speakers and the attendees. The appreciation also extends to everyone who had contributed their precious time and effort to make this symposium a fruitful and successful event.



The ICSA is organized and operated for educational, charitable, and scientific purposes according to its constitution. These purposes pertain not only to statistics as knowledge and methodology, but also to the statisticians as professionals and individuals. How to equip our members to be good statisticians in academia, industry, and government is one of most important goals, because many of our student members came to North America to study statistics, and they will face a transition from being a student to getting a job and entering the profession." In the coming ICSA general meeting, a special "How To" session will follow the business meeting. Four panelists will talk about their own transition experiences and offer advice about job search, interview, and adjustment to the working environment. Each gives a 15 minutepresentation followed by a question and answer period. The panelists are willing to serve as advisors in the future through e-mail, FAX, and telephone.

FROM THE CHAIR EDITOR OF STATISTICA SINICA

Dear ICSA Members:

I am very pleased to inform you that *Statistica Sinica* was ranked highly in Scientific Citation Index(SCI) reports. It moved from 22 in 1992 to 19 in 1993. Detailed information on the rankings are given below. SCI is the authoritative agency which ranks scholarly journals in many scientific disciplines. Its reports are often used by universities and research institutions for peer reviews and promotion reviews.

Since Statistica Sinica was first published in 1991, 1992 was the first year when it was eligible for the SCI rankings. It did very well from the BEGINNING. It continues its improvement in the 1993 rankings (from 22 to 19, see Tables 1 and 2 below), outperforming many journals which have been around for 20-50 years! Statistica Sinica is only five years old. Among new journals(those too young to have a cited half-life), Statistica Sinica is ranked the BEST! By excluding journals that are not primarily statistics/probability (eg, econometrics, psychometrics, fuzzy, game, chemometrics), Statistica Sinica is ranked 16 in 1992 and 15 in 1993. By further excluding probability journals, Statistica Sinica is ranked 12 in 1993 among statistical journals.

This above information can be used to promote the image of *Statistica Sinica*. Often people's reactions was "well, it is a new journal and I am not sure how my colleagues will view the quality of *Statistica Sinica*." We can tell them we are ranked quite highly. On several occasions I found people were very surprised that we do better than many well known journals(see the lists below) which have been around for 20-50 years.

I urge you to use this information in ---getting library subscription, ---recruiting good papers, ---spreading good words about Statistica Sinica.
